### NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS (REGISTRATION OF ORGANIZATIONSOPERATING PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF ACT) ORDER.

Period within which Non-Governmental Organisations operating prior to commencement of Act shall be required to register under Act. CAP. 315.

2. Non-Governmental Organisations already in existence and operating prior to the commencement of the Non-Governmental Organisations Act shall be and are hereby required to register under the Act from the date the Act comes into force until the 4th day of July, 2001, both days inclusive.
