REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW NGOs INTENDING TO REGISTER WITH RRC

- 1) A cover letter on a headed paper addressed to the Director General of NGOs Affairs requesting registration (RRC, HQ Juba);
- 2) The profile / Concept Paper
- 3) A copy of the constitution
- 4) Locations/coverage and contact person (Country Director) including phone number and email address
- 5) Two recent passport size photographs of three top official of the organisation with the names written at the black and copies of ID cards/passports
- 6) Proposed one-year budget of the applicant organization applying for registration;
- 7) Registration fees \$200 US dollars for International NGOs and \$150 US dollars for National NGO's.

Notes:

- 1. Inquiry on the status of the registration should be done after three working days.
- 2. All applications must be typed or filled in block letters
- 3. All signatures must be in original form, scanned and copies will not be accepted
- 4. No organisation will be allowed to operate in South Sudan without a certificate of operation issued by Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC);
- 5. Registered organization will be subject to all laws of the government of the Republic of South Sudan;
